How our pricing works

We work out the price you pay for Ordnance Survey data and its associated licence based on your choice of the pricing variables described in this section. We apply these in all our quotations prior to sale and to all orders you place through OS Orders, our online ordering service. We will show you where these variables have been applied to your price before you commit to buying a data licence from us.

Prices include initial data supply to you, a one-year licence for your use of the data to support your internal business administration, and the supply of any available updates during the lifetime of your licence.

Your choices

The price you pay is based on choices you make on OS Orders. These are:

- The product(s) you require.
- The area of data* or amount of data** required for each product licensed – we call this the “Price Unit”.
- The total number of terminals (as defined in our data licence contracts) on which you will use the data for the duration of your licence, including those used by contractors working for you – see the Terminal discounts section on page 4 for further details.
- Licence length – 1, 2 or 3 years to suit your needs

* You choose the geographical area of data for which you wish to buy a licence when you use OS Orders.

** We also supply some products in standard National Grid*** areas, for example 1 kilometre x 1 kilometre (abbreviated to km). We call these “tiles”. We indicate where tile supply applies under each product entry, also including the size of tile that applies for that product.

*** The National Grid is the map reference system used on all Ordnance Survey products to identify the position of any feature. See our website for further details.

Terminal discounts

We use the number of terminals to differentiate between larger and smaller customers. We show the headline price for any product based on use by a large customer on 101 or more terminals. We call this “Corporate Use”. If you are a smaller user, you simply choose the terminal band that applies to you. The discount is applied automatically when you use OS Orders.

The following discounts apply when you license more than 8% of Great Britain, measured against the product’s National Price for Corporate Use.

We modify these discounts when you license an area less than 8% of Great Britain by value. The modified discount is also applied automatically when you use OS Orders.

Minimum charges

Minimum Annual Contract Values apply as follows:

For each OS MasterMap product and AddressBase product separately licensed - £500 p.a.

For each of OS VectorMap® Local Raster, 1:25 000 Scale Colour Raster, 1:50 000 Scale Colour Raster, Code-Point®, Code-Point with polygons, OS VectorMap Local and OS Terrain® 5 - £100 p.a.

We **do not** apply a minimum charge to any of the products above if you choose to increase the amount of data you wish to hold (we call this a “contract expansion”) or to adjust your licence in some way, for example, to increase your number of terminals.

Buying additional data sharing rights

You can buy these additional rights – we call it “Corporate Group Licensing “– when you have licensed certain products for the whole of Great Britain for your Corporate Use. When you buy these rights, you can share data with other companies in the same Group of Companies as you.

Management of your licensed data contract

You will manage your contract through OS Orders. You should note that each separate order you make is subject to a minimum of a one-year term.

Where relevant, we will use your order history for your contract when calculating the price of any new orders for the same product.

We will treat each contract separately should you choose to have multiple contracts.

Please note that each separate order you make is subject to a one-year minimum term.

Price Unit: A 1 km x 1 km grid of Great Britain based on the National Grid where each kilometre square is classified as one of three descriptive Geography Types shown in the table below. We work out your price to the nearest hectare when you either use an area pre-defined by Ordnance Survey or define your own in OS Orders.

OS MasterMap Topography Layer (as an example of an OS Master Map product)

Customer wants a contract for 15 terminals covering an area of interest of 50,000 km² made up of: 2,000 km² Settlement; 13,000 km² Rural; 35,000 km² Moorland.

Pricing is a simple 2-step process as follows:

Step 1 – First, calculate a Base Price using prices shown on page 6

Step 2 – Next, apply the Terminal discount shown on page 4

Customer requires use on 15 terminals required, therefore, terminal band used for pricing is 11–20.

We apply 40% discount because the Base Price Total is greater than 8% of the Great Britain price (using the first table on page 4).

Step 2 price = £293,797.00 (i.e. £489,661.67 less 40%)

This is the price for a one-year contract only

AddressBase (as an example of an AddressBase product)

Customer wants a contract for 15 terminals for an area of interest that contains 6,000,000 address records. Pricing is the same simple 2-step process as shown above:

Step 1 – First, calculate a Base Price using prices shown on page 8

Step 2 – Next, apply the Terminal discount shown on page 4

Customer requires use on 15 terminals required, therefore, terminal band used for pricing is 11–20.

We apply 40% discount because the Base Price Total is greater than 8% of the Great Britain price (using the first table on page 4).

Step 2 price = £6,828.00 (i.e. £11,380.00 less 40%)

This is the price for a one-year contract

OS Vector Map Local (as an example of a priced-by-tile product)

Customer wants a contract for 5 terminals covering an area of interest of containing 150 tiles. Pricing is the same simple 2-step process as shown above:

Step 1 – First, calculate a Base Price using prices on page 9

Step 1 Base Price = £3,691.50 (i.e. £24.61 x 150)

Step 2 – Next, apply the Terminal discount shown on page 4

Customer requires use on 5 terminals, therefore, terminal band used for pricing is 3-5.

The value is 1.42% of the Great Britain price (i.e. £3,691.50/£259,750.00 x 100%). As this is less than 8% of the Great Britain price the second table on page 4 is now used.

We apply a 60% discount (discovered by reading across the **≥1% but <2%** row and down the **3-5 terminals** column in the table)

The price for a one-year contract is £1,476.60 (i.e. £3,691.50 less 60%)
